Back to School

Following a review of the modes of delivery being offered by Catholic Education WA, it has been decided that as of Monday 18th May, we will return to our normal modes of instruction. This has mostly been happening in our classrooms over the past week anyway, given we have been back to over a daily attendance of 95%. Although there will be a return to the usual face-to-face teaching, we will still continue to utilise the online apps of Teams (Years 3 - 6) and SeeSaw (Kindy – Year 2) to assist learning and communicate with parents. Drive Through

I would like to thank parents for their patience and understanding as we try to get roughly 100 children into cars after school each day. We try to do this as quickly as possible, but sometimes there can be hold ups. I encourage parents to continue to follow road rules when waiting to enter the Drive Through, including not blocking the entrance to The River, pulling up onto the kerb or blocking the footpath crossings. The Rangers will continue to monitor this situation and I would hate to see any of our parents fined for breaching these laws. I encourage parents to perhaps come a little later if they have a child in Years 1-6, so we can move the Kindy and Pre-Primary children first. Another option could be parking at the Church or Recreation Centre and collecting children from the crosswalk, instead of using the Drive Through. I would like to remind parents that they are required to follow the Government guidelines in relation to not coming onto school grounds. This means parents are required to remain in their cars and only pick up children from the crosswalk. Please do not park your car in the Drive Through to collect children. The staff will continue to collect children in the morning and deliver them to parents in the afternoon to assist with this. This also applies if needing to pick up or drop off at the school during the day. I appreciate your support and assistance with this.

Kindy Enrolments for 2021

I am currently taking enrolments for Kindy for 2021. Places are beginning to fill and as we are limited to 20 places, I would hate to have families miss out. Pre-Kindy Opportunity

Our school has been granted the opportunity to offer a 3-Year-Old Kindergarten program. We need to determine the feasibility of offering this service both for this year (with a possibility of commencing either at the start of Term 3 or Term 4) and next year. Only children who have turned 3 may attend this program. Program days and costs are yet to be determined. 

Absentees




A reminder to parents that there is a simple way to let us know your child is absent from school, while providing a note at the same time. Jump on our app or website!
