#### **Kindy Enrolments for 2021**

I am currently taking enrolments for Kindy for 2021. Places are beginning to fill and as we are limited to 20 places, I would hate to have families miss out. If you, or someone you know, has a child who will turn 4 by 30 June 2021, please either contact the office for an enrolment form or visit our website to download the forms and return them to the school.

#### **Pre-Kindy Opportunity**

Our school has been granted the opportunity to offer a 3-Year-Old Kindergarten program. We need to determine the feasibility of offering this service both for this year (with a possibility of commencing either at the start of Term 3 or Term 4) and next year. Only children who have turned 3 may attend this program. The program will be run for one full day a week. For this year, the program will run on a Friday and next year on a Thursday. The costs are yet to be determined. #### Just a Reminder

Some aspects of our COVID-19 response plan will remain in place until further notice:

- 1. Parents and all non-essential visitors will not be permitted to enter the school grounds.
- 2 Activities such as assemblies, incursions, interschool sporting events and carnivals, and sacramental celebrations will remain prohibited.
- 3. Additional cleaning regimes will remain in place.
- 4. Current hygiene practices will remain in place.
- 5. Current social distancing requirements will remain in place for staff.
- 6. Social distancing requirements, while not compulsory, will be encouraged and implemented where practical and possible for students.

#### **Semester Reports**

As directed by the Premier Mark McGowan in his address on 13 May, teachers will be required to report to parents with information about students' learning progress to date in Semester One, but they will not be required to assign an A-E grade. These changes recognise the impact of COVID-19 on teaching in Western Australia and provides parents and carers with reliable information regarding student progress. Interim Reports, demonstrating where each child is at in each learning area and providing a general comment, will be accessible online using the SEQTA Engage platform at the end of the last week of Term 2.


