#### **Fourth Week of Lent**



Arsad, an Indonesian farmer, had no toilet in his house, so always had to walk into the forest to the open defecation area. His family was often sick and open defecation caused many neighbourhood disputes. With the support of Caritas Australia and its partner agency, Laz Harfa, Arsad took part in hygiene, sanitation and financial management training. He then funded the building of a toilet in his house and helped other community members to save money to construct their own toilet.

Now, Arsad's family is healthier, their community no longer practices open defecation and is more harmonious. Arsad inspired his community to 'Be More.'

Around 17 percent of Indonesia's rural population, or 45 million people, practice open defecation – going to the toilet outdoors in fields, forests and other open spaces. (World Bank)





### **School Dental Service**

Rapids Landing Dental Therapy Centre is located at Rapids Landing Primary School, 42 Tonkin Blvd, Margaret River.

Children in Pre- primary (aged 5 years) to Year 11 (aged 16) are eligible for free dental care from the School Dental Service.

School Dental Service in Term 1 will issue an enrolment form to <u>all Pre- Primary & new students</u> to the area through their respective school.

If you wish to enrol your child please complete both forms (white & green) and return via child's school.

If you do not wish to participate in the School Dental Service or already attending a private dentist, please continue care with the family dentist, you do not need to return the forms.

Parents and guardians who have completed and returned the enrolment form via their school will receive an appointment letter in the post with a SMS reminder 2 days prior to an appointment over the coming year.
