
A warm welcome back to Term Two.



Just a reminder that we are still waiting for an order of long sleeved white shirts to come in as well as smaller sizes of the sport shorts.


Until the shirts arrive you can still wear the short sleeved shirts with the winter uniform. Sorry for the inconvenience.


