This Sunday is Pentecost, sometimes referred to as the birthday of our Church. We celebrated this morning with a whole school mass in the church led by our beautiful Year 2 students. Pentecost is when we celebrate the Holy Spirit coming upon the disciples of Jesus, as He promised to guide them and be with them until the end of time.


