

200 Years of Catholic Education

On Monday 24th May, the Feast of Our Lady Help of Christians, the Patroness of Australia, 200 years of Catholic Education in Australia was celebrated with a Mass, marking the bicentenary of the first Catholic school established in Paramatta in October 1820. Over 200 years, Catholic schools have grown to become the largest provider of schooling in Australia (outside government) with one in five school age students attending a Catholic school. This represents 777,000 students in 1,755 schools across the country and employing over 100,000 teachers and staff. Nearly 40 per cent of



Catholic schools are located outside of metropolitan cities in regional, rural and remote communities. The national theme, 'Faith in the future' reflects the core purpose of catholic education to form students in their faith and provide an education that allows students to make a meaningful contribution to our world. This directly reflects our own Vision statement — *Inspiring life-long learners to live their faith and contribute positively to their world.*

National Sorry Day

Yesterday, we recognised National Sorry Day - a day that remembers and acknowledges the mistreatment of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people who were forcibly removed from their families and communities, which we now know as 'The Stolen Generations'. This day provides an opportunity for us to reflect on how we can all play a part in the healing process for our people and nation. The students completed a range of activities to acknowledge and further understand this day.


