The theme for Child Protection Week is 'Every child, in every community, needs a fair go'. The little things we do every day can help to create safer environments for children. For instance:

EVERY CHIL

- Stop and listen to children when they are talking to you
- Be an advocate for children if necessary or help them share their views
- Be a good role model around children
- Stand up for children if you see that they are not being heard
- Look out for signs of abuse or neglect; if you suspect something is wrong talk to an expert
- Always take reports of abuse seriously
- Avoid blame and don't judge; instead, ask yourself what you can do to help
- Listen to the needs of children and spend time with them
- Be aware of the United Nations Conventions on the Rights of the Child and help to implement these.

We invite families to join us tomorrow morning for the Year 5 Assembly, commencing at 8:45am. I wish all Fathers, Grandfathers, Uncles and Significant men in the lives of the children a wonderful Father's Day on Sunday. Have a fantastic week ahead.


