The remaining assessments will be completed next week with Reading on Tuesday, Language Conventions on Wednesday and Numeracy on Thursday

Third Week of Lent



We are now in the third week of Lent with Project Compassion we here about the story of Priscilla from Zimbabwe. Priscilla lives in the Hwange district in Zimbabwe, where the impacts of climate change are exacerbating food insecurity in vulnerable communities. This can be seen in the erratic rainfall patterns, prolonged dry spells, poor agricultural soils and high temperatures in the region.

Priscilla joined the Zimbabwe Integrated Community Development Program, implemented by our partner Caritas Hwange and funded by Caritas Australia. Through the program, Priscilla and her community learnt conservation farming techniques to grow drought-resistant crops to help mitigate the effects of climate change.

Priscilla was able to produce a bumper harvest in her first year of practicing in conservation farming.

First Reconciliation


