Simultaneous Storytime







National Simultaneous Storytime (NSS) is held annually by the Australian Library and Information Association (ALIA). Every year a picture book, written and illustrated by an Australian author and illustrator, is read simultaneously in libraries, schools and other institutions around the country at the same time. It aims to promote the value of reading and literacy, using an Australian children's book that explores age-appropriate themes. This year's book, The Speedy Sloth, is a story about a sloth that loves to run around FAST! He goes on an adventure in the rainforest, challenging other animals to a race. He learns some important lessons along the way.

National Sorry Day

Tomorrow, we will recognise National Sorry Day – a day that remembers and acknowledges the mistreatment of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people who were forcibly removed from their families and communities, which we now know as 'The Stolen Generations'. This day provides an opportunity for us to reflect on how we can all play a part in the healing process for our people and nation. The students will complete a range of activities to acknowledge and further understand this day.

Place Based Learning



On Tuesday afternoon, the staff met with Leon Ridgeway, the Aboriginal Education consultant from the Catholic Education Bunbury office. He worked with the staff to help further develop an understanding of the importance of incorporating the local environment and history into our everyday lessons and helping our students better understand connection to country and how we can continue to respect the land we live on. Already our students are learning some great things, including local Noongar words, the history of the Margaret River and local area and planting Indigenous plants both in our own Indigenous Garden and at the Rivermouth

Pentecost

This Sunday we celebrate Pentecost – the conclusion to the Easter season and the day that celebrates the beginning of the Church – the Church's birthday! Pentecost occurs 50 days after Easter Sunday and is celebrated to acknowledge when the Holy Spirit descended onto the Apostles and Mary, which effectively started the beginning of the Church, as the Apostles then went out to preach the Good News and about 3000 people were baptised. I encourage families to come to Mass this Sunday at 10:00am to celebrate the Church's birthday.




Rapids Landing Dental Therapy Centre
