Research from the Centre for Education Statistics and Evaluation has identified 7 themes that are important for effective student learning in schools. These include setting high expectations for students, explicitly teaching content, providing effective feedback, using data to inform teaching practices, managing the classroom effectively, providing opportunities for wellbeing and collaborating with others. While I believe our teachers incorporate many of these aspects already, it is always timely to review this in the context of our school and refine practices to make them even better. As we continue to strive to be the best school in Margaret River, our staff continually show their commitment and dedication to providing the best learning experiences for your children through reflection and continual learning.




